## VHFF HANDS OVER FEVER SENSING UNIT TO NMIA



Diaspora representatives along with government and airport officials were on hand to witness the official handing over of the thermal scanning machine to the Norman Manley International Airport (NMIA) by the Vincent HoSang Family Foundation, VHFF in Kingston, Jamaica, recently.

The donation is the third of its kind, as two similar thermal scanning machines were airmarked for the Sangster International Airport in Montego Bay and the Falmouth Cruise Ship Complex in Trelawny, donated by Jamaica-based Sagicor Insurance Group and Supreme Ventures, respectively.

The VHFF is Jamaican-owned and is an affiliate of Caribbean Food Delights (CFD), the largest global frozen food manufacturer of Jamaican Style Patties; Royal Caribbean Bakery and JerkQ'zine Caribbean Grille.

### A Letter from the President of Royal Caribbean Bakery

Dear Family, Friends & Valued Customers,

You may know me as a wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, friend, business owner and philanthropist. As some of you may not know, I have end stage renal disease and I am currently on peritoneal dialysis ten hours each day for seven days a week. I am in urgent need of a kidney. I have been on the transplant list at New York Presbyterian Hospital for four years now. A living donor kidney is my best and safest chance at a longer and healthier life.

I have been a diabetic for 30 years, giving myself insulin injections daily. It has been 30 years of arduous regimens and medication that has led to my kidney failure.

As I continue to give back to my community, I am now reaching out to all of you. I am asking for someone who is healthy and willing to donate a kidney to me. Please consider this donation as

your gift of life to someone in need.

If you would like to become my living donor, please call the number below to schedule an appointment to find out if you are eligible. Medical exams related to kidney donation will be at no cost to you. Mention you are signing up to be considered as a donor for Jeanette HoSang.

Even if you choose not to become a living donor, you may register to become an organ donor through your state's Department of Motor Vehicles or go to [organdonor.gov](http://organdonor.gov). I am one of many people waiting for a transplant. Many die waiting for an organ. Your life could save up to eight lives.

### Facts About Organ Donation:

- Every ten minutes someone is added to an organ waiting list.
- 22 people die each day waiting for a transplant.
- You do not have to be a match to donate your kidney. Donor and recipient may do Kidney Paired Donation to swap donors for better matched recipients.
- There is no cost to the donor for donor-related medical procedures as it covered by the recipient's health insurance.
- By Federal law, it is illegal to accept compensation for donating an organ
- One life may save up to eight lives and enhance many others
- Most major religions in the United States support organ donation and consider donation as the final act of love and generosity toward others
